Teach a Problem

Week 2

Lesson Plan:

Practice solving a problem using a systematic method, then practice breaking down the problem in order to teach it to peers, practice explaining the process.

Intended Learning Outcomes:

- Practice using HtDF
- Develop greater understanding of each of the parts of HtDF
- Develop understanding of the importance of readability
- Practice public speaking
- Associate course vocabulary to HtDF recipe steps

Required Materials:

- 1) Projector/ computer

Lesson Procedure		
	Resource(s)	Time
Warm-up/ Intro Task(s)		5 - 10 mins
Put students back into the groups they were in from their content tutorial. Remind them of the day's topic, and give them 5 minutes to discuss/ get reacquainted.		
Main Task 1 - Teaching	Projector/ computer	45-50 mins
Each group will take turns teaching the class how to use the HtDF recipe correctly so that the mistakes in the provided solution are not made. They must all speak, so they should take turns. They may use their notes from the Content Tutorial for guidance.		

Comments / Notes:

In the intro task, remind the class that they are not teaching the whole recipe, just a portion of it based on the mistakes found in the Content Tutorial exercise.

Each group will have only 5 minutes to present their lesson. Setup a visible timer for the students.
